




Figure 4. Murrells Inlet: Even Closer NLCD Land Cover 2001 (Golland, 2021).




Fig. 2 (Created by: Nina McCoy)


# Why is Bucksport Special?




# Deforested Area in Bucksport




Horry County has lost over 5.32% of its total wetland area since 1996. 74.75 square miles of Palustrine forested wetlands were lost.

Waccamaw Wildlife Refuge is home to "striped bass, American shad, blueback herring, and two endangered sturgeon species are among migratory fish species that live part of their lives in saltwater and swim up rivers to spawn"





Fig. 18 (Made using ArcGIS Survey 123)





Fig. 19 (Made using ArcGIS Survey 123)

It would be beneficial to figure out what major changes to the landscape and infrastructure occurred during that turning point.

- Green = 1 flooding event in 5 years
- Yellow = 2 events in 5 years
- Blue = 3 events in 5 years
- Red = 4 + events in 5 years

# Some takeaways and data

- 17 interns in the spring
- 20 interns in the summer
- 43% minority group in the spring
- 28% minority group in the summer
- Majority are juniors and seniors
- About 50% are from SC and the majority say they would live and work in Georgetown County if they had the opportunity
- 30-40% were offered employment
- Many discovered the beauty of Georgetown county, per the comments

## SDG GOAL EIGHT


- Remote work by allowing flexible work schedules, lower fuel emissions, less building space, and less utility usage, which affects the economy positively


## SDG GOAL NINE

# Using Data to tell our story



We believe Data is a combination of "Expert Knowledge" and "Community Knowledge".



We use the data to provide the framework for storytelling and narrative shaping.



Our goal is to make the data easy to understand and accessible.



We use the data as a tool for grantmakers in making decisions about where and how to invest.

# Dashboard aligns CCF's goals to the SDGs, and provides data relevant to each SDG

- Allows for users to target specific organization goals
- Allows for users to target specific SDGs
- Allows for users to target specific counties
- Provides cross-county visual comparisons
- Deep-dive within a county on a specific SDG

# CCF data dashboard provides users with a wealth of reliable data

- Includes over 1,000 pieces of data on 10 counties on the South Carolina coast
- Key data from trustworthy sources
  - FEMA
  - US Census
  - KIDS Count
- Organized to allow for ease of communication
  - Maps, graphs, visuals

# Dashboard supports internal and external decision-making processes

- Supports decisions being made with reliable external data
- Communicates to stakeholders what external data is valuable to the organization
- Provides data for partners pursuing grant opportunities or conducting other professional work with CCF
- Provides a marker for strategic planning that can later be revisited for evaluation purposes
- Communicates the SDGs as relevant and important to the work of the organization

Dashboard has the potential to be updated and change, reflecting movement of the org

- Can evolve and flex with CCF
- Show change over time on key metrics
- Show change in priorities and areas of focus
- Additional SDGs as needed
